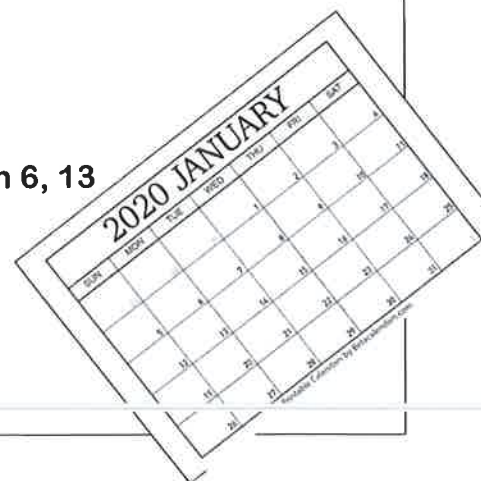

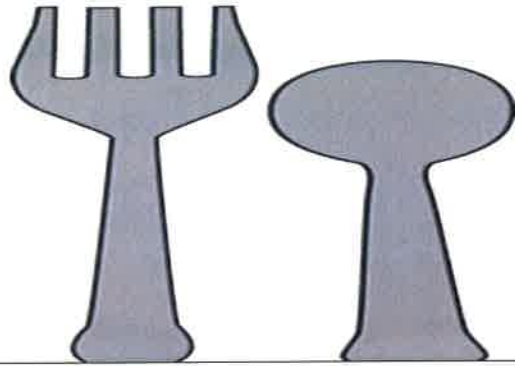
## IMPORTANT NOTICE

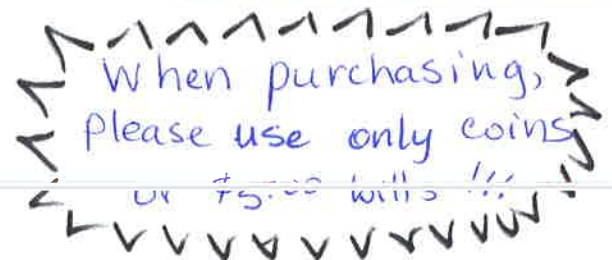
